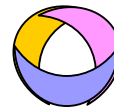
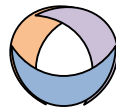
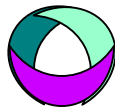

*Built in 1894, the building was originally used as a church. Now a meeting place for the Deaf Community, the hall can also be hired out for parties, meetings, courses, fairs and fetes and most other events*

*The hall can host a maximum of 110 people and offers a kitchen, staffed bar, dance floor and a smaller meeting room. We also have a children's play area and small car park.*
